## Bali 4.4 - Aft slider door – roller repair

- 1. Remove the 4 spacer blocks inside the slide frame. Top and bottom in the middle of the frame and the 2 port side of the frame.
- 2. Slide door as far to the port and lift out.
- 3. Remove screw at the bottom of the door, opposite the latch. This will be corroded, so I had to drill it out. I actually didn't replace the screw.
- 4. Caution: You need to slide the door frame apart at that corner, just enough to get the 2 bearing holders out of the frame.
  - Lubricate window by seals, it will make getting the frame slide back over the window much easier.
  - DO NOT separate frame TOO much!





## Bali 4.4 - Aft slider door – roller repair

- 1. There are 2 housing (that slide) that hold 2 rollers each.
- 2. DO NOT damage the black outer housing that holders the rollers
- 3. Use nylon groove rollers (<a href="https://www.amazon.com/dp/B000I1TD7C?ref=fed\_asin\_title">https://www.amazon.com/dp/B000I1TD7C?ref=fed\_asin\_title</a>)
  - Grid down the diameter using a drill with bolt and nut holding the roller. Grind it down to the size that fits in the housing. It takes a few iterations.
- 4. Use Nylon screw and threaded insert. I fitted them at the local HW store.
- 5. In order fit the housing back in the door, there can't be too much width, so I grinded down the nylon screw head and insert.
  - It fits snug so the key is the pin the rollers sit on are solid.
- 6. Re-install housings in door slide, separating them towards the ends of the door
- 7. Slide the frame together, making sure the rubber seal around the glass is not folded under.
